The next most important industry in building up a solid and permanent prosperity.
Something ought to be done in Salem towards abating the nuisance of peddlers. They come here and take orders for outside merchandise, going from house to house, and they cannot be reached. Is there not some way that may be devised to reach them? Those who come with the goods and deliver them from house to house may get by with a dollar a day license. That is not enough. The men who pay the taxes and the rents and help to make Salem a city worth living in ought to be protected. Suggestions are in order.

EVADING RESPONSIBILITY
Numerous are the methods for evasion of taxes. Recently a man worth the startling sum of fifty million dollars passed on. It is reported that he left all of this vast accumulation of wealth here on earth invested in tax-exempt bonds. He had paid no income tax to the federal government for many years. He had invested no money in establishing industries in building homes or in commercial enterprises and paid but a few dollars local taxes.

EVADING RESPONSIBILITY (continued)
During these years when this man of money paid no taxes the expenses of the federal government had to be paid. State and local taxes were also collected. And they were met by taxpayers indirectly as in the case of the federal government or directly in case of smaller political units.

EVADING RESPONSIBILITY (continued)
And unlike the bond investor these taxpayers have invested their money in commerce, in industry, in building homes and in other constructive effort which is most heavily burdened by taxes with which to meet the expenses of government.

EVADING RESPONSIBILITY (continued)
Among other phases of the situation which makes the action of the tax dodger more reprehensible is the fact that the taxpaying investor is the one who provides opportunity for the great mass of workers to earn a livelihood and to establish and maintain homes for their families. Without the investor in industry and commerce there would in fact be no progress.

EVADING RESPONSIBILITY (continued)
One of the great needs of today is more money for investment. And one reason for this need is the billions of dollars invested and being invested in non-taxable securities. Further issuance of this type of securities should be permitted only in case of emergency. If congress will not serve the public interest in this way, the states should include them under specific inheritances.

No class or classes of individuals should be permitted to enjoy the privileges of government and force others to pay all or even an unjust proportion of the taxes.
