RAT EXTERMINATION COSTLY

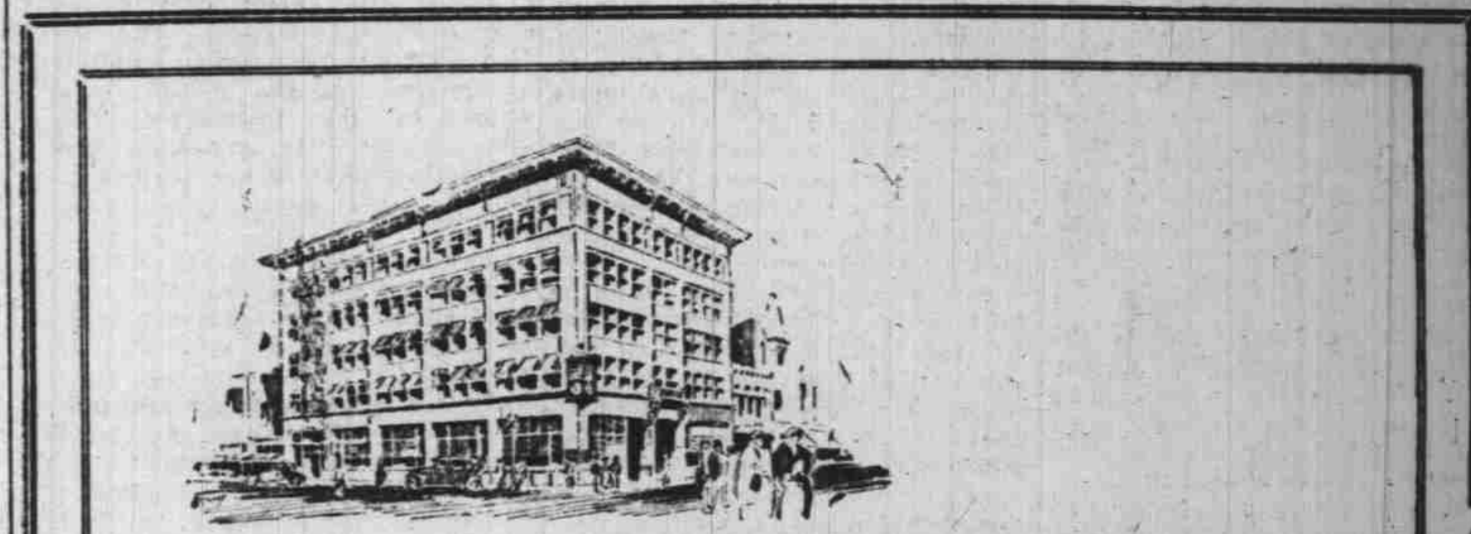
