**Like Apparatus of 1799**

LONDON—The Royal Air Force  
today is using a parachute perfect-  
ed by an American, which fact has  
brought out comment and dis-  
cussion as to the history of the  
use of parachutes in aeronautics.  
The assertion is made that the  
first live-saver of this kind was  
conceived 132 years ago by Jac-  
ques Garnerin, a Frenchman. He  
worked out the idea while a pris-  
oner of the Germans in the Ehren-  
breitstein fortress, at Coblenz on the  
Rhine, and with a parasol-like  
contrivance dropped safely from  
the fortress walls to liberty.
