

DEBT PARLEY EXPECTED
FRENCH COMMISSION TO U. S.
LOOKED FOR

PARIS, July 1.—(By the Associated Press.)—According to persistent reports current in competent circles, France, following the example of Belgium, is about to send a commission to Washington to negotiate the funding of the French debt to the United States. Foreign Minister Briand is said to regard the time as opportune to initiate negotiations. This view is shared by Finance Minister Gallaux, and official announcement of decision to send the commission is expected at an early date.

SAN DIEGO, Cal., June 30.—That John D. Worthington, the "wolf of La Salle street," accused of theft of \$100,000 in securities from the firm of S. F.
