try, which was reported as 7 to 8 pounds in 1922. The national average was raised from 1.85 pounds in 1840 to its present size, and is still improving with careful selection of stock. It is significant, says the experiment station authorities, to note many bands in Oregon average 10 pounds. Careful cutting of poor fleece bearers is being conducted by different growers with a view to raise the average weight still further.

Comparatively few Oregon produce certified potato seed. Three trips must be made by the O.A.C. extension service specialists to the farms of those who attempt it. The growers usually receive a premium for their seed, so a small fee is asked to help pay the expenses.

Hungarian vetch has a number of qualifications that make it an outstanding crop in many Oregon situations. Being a legume it increases the amount of nitrogen in the soil. It is excellent as a storage crop giving hay, silage, soilage, and pasture equal in palatability and nutritive value to that of any other annual legume.

Beehives should not rest directly upon the ground. Timbers two by six inches, or bricks, or special stands may be used for supports, a stand six inches high being the best. A sloping board should be placed from the ground to the entrance to permit heavily laden bees that drop near the hive to reach the entrance. The hives should be level from side to side, but should slant slightly toward the opening. The hives should be so placed that it will not be necessary to pass directly in front of them while working in the yard.

CORE BREAKDOWN OF VALLEY PEARS
College Authority Says It May Be Controlled by Early Picking

Pear growers of the Willamette valley may protect their fruit core breakdown by early picking. Investigations by Henry Hartman of the Oregon Agricultural college experiment station indicate that Bartlett pears picked when the pressure test shows a pressure of 27 pounds or more show approximately no core breakdown, even after the fruit has been in cold storage for as much as 125 days. Tests were made with other leading pear varieties of the district showing that when the fruit is picked before it is too mature very little core breakdown trouble is encountered.

Willamette valley growers seem to suffer more from breakdown trouble than growers of eastern and southern Oregon. This, Mr. Hartman thinks, is because the valley growers assume that their season is three weeks later than the southern Oregon season, and that they should pick their pears three weeks later. This is an error, Mr. Hartman says, as the later valley season more nearly coincides with the season in southern Oregon.

other insects the station has sent out press material sufficient to handle the matter. If the plants can be made to make speedy and vigorous growth from the start they generally keep pretty well ahead of insect set-backs.
For gardeners who, like myself, grow cucumbers only for home use a method providing a "little shade" for young plants in hot weather is entirely feasible. A wide board may be propped on the south side of east-and-west rows, leaning sharply over the hills to keep the hottest noon-time sun off. This plan might prove too expensive for commercial growers. I do not know. But it means better fruit for the same device will keep the sun from scorching the young cukes. If the

rows run north-and-south a 12-inch board be put up on four legs—one at each corner—just over the hills. This will allow the sun to shine on the plants evenings and mornings, but will keep the worst of the noon time sun from them. I always keep a half dozen boards on legs ready for such plants as lettuce and spinach in hot summer weather.
