Antelope Herd Thrives in Canadian National Park

CALGARY. Alts. - Antelone which were threatened with extinction in Canada have been successfully preserved in Nemiskam National Park. When the preserve was established in 1915 there were only 45 in the herd, the last survivors of the thousands that once had roamed the prairies. There are now 235 animals in the herd, a gain of 190. How well they breed in captivity is shown by the fact that there was an

increase of 55 in 1924 alone. Anteiope once were prized trophies and suffered such ravages. in numbers that extinction of the species was in sight. A herd finally was discovered in Southern acres on which the animals were feeding was surrounded by a fence of woven wire and all the work as done ithout disturbing the animals.


Many Important Conferences Staged
