Complete American Home to Be Shipped to France
NEW YORK—A model American home of ten rooms and three baths, built and completely furnished in New York, will be shipped to France and set up in the Grand Palais at Paris as a part of the American section of the international exhibition of household and labor saving devices, October 22 to November 15. It was announced here today by Arthur Williams, vice president of the New York Edison company, who has been chosen president of the American section of the exhibition. The house will be an American gift to the French department of public instruction under whose auspices the exhibition will be held.

Philippines' Sugar Crop Larger Than Last Year
MANILA.—The total sugar crop of the Philippine Islands for 1924-1925 is placed at 48,175 metric tons in an estimate compiled by the Philippine Sugar association. This is an increase of 112,421 tons over the 1923-1924 crop. The estimate places the centrifugal sugar production at 42,843 tons, and the muscovado production at 65,332 tons, compared with 314,836 and 59,918 tons, respectively, in the crop year 1923-1924. Virtually all of the centrifugal sugar is marketed in the United States, while the muscovado output nearly all goes to China and Japan.

Giant Tree is Named for Secretary Wm. M. Jardine
LOGAN, Utah.—In honor of Secretary of Agriculture William M. Jardine, a giant juniper tree, recently discovered in Logan Canyon near here and declared to be the oldest and largest one of its kind in the world, has been named "Juniper Jardine." The tree has a circumference of about 28 feet and is claimed by local residents to be the oldest living thing with the possible exception of the redwood trees in California. Secretary Jardine was present at the christening which took place at a reunion of the class of 1904, Utah Agricultural college, of which he is an member.
