"Your honor, I feel that I have been convicted of violating an unjust statute," Scopes replied. "I will continue in the future as I have in the past, to oppose this law in any way I can. Any other action would be in violation of my ideal of academic freedom—that is, to teach the truth, as guaranteed in our constitution of personal and religious freedom. I think the fine is unjust."
A fine of \$100 was then imposed and when bond was made later in the afternoon the Scopes case was at an end in Dayton, with Knoxville the next field of action.
