They believe their proof is complete that Schwartz planned the killing for months to defraud the insurance companies out of more than \$100,000 which he carried in favor of Mrs. Schwartz and the Cellulose company, in which she was a heavy stockholder.

His note, the police believe, was a dying effort to erase the image of himself as a premeditated murderer in the minds of his wife and children, when his suicide should reveal his plot to take his own death in the Walnut creek fire,
