In consequence, the agreement aid down a schedule of repayment for the pre-armistice loans which provides that Belgium shall pay \$1,000,000 in 1926, and the same amount in 1927, with increases in each of the next four years until in 1932 the annual payment becomes \$2,900,000. It will continue at this figure until 1987. when a final payment of \$2,280,-000 will be due.

"Post armistice debt." was fixed at \$246,000,000 including accrued injerest. While interest on this was fixed at the rate of 3 % per ent, the Americans agreed to forego a part of the interest for the first 10 years and arbitrary amounts were established, bringing a reduction of nearly \$50. 000.000.

The settlement is considered to be effective from June 15, last, and for the first year, Belgium wi.l pay the United States \$1.749,-000 as interest on the post armistice debt, and \$1,100,000 on the principal or a total of \$2,840,000. The second year the total payment will be \$3,100,000 of which \$2, 000,000 will be interest and \$1,-100,000 principal. The charge o interest will increase sharply in each succeeding year, and the amount for principal will increase at a lesser rate, until in the eleventh year Belgium will pay \$8,172,500 interest and \$1.600. 000 principal, a total of \$9,772, 500. Payments thereafter will remain in excess of \$9,000,000 per annum until the full term of 6: years has run out, and the debt has been extinguished.

YARDS ARE AUTHORIZED

EUGENE TO TURN SITE OVER TO RAILROAD COMPANY

EUGENE. Or., Aug. 18 .- At an election here today, citizens of Eugene, by a 10 to 1 vote, authorized the issuance of \$175,000 in bonds for the purchase of a tehminal site of 209 acres immediately north of the city, to be turned over to the Southern Pacific company as a site for their Natron cut-off shops, terminals, tie treating plant, etc. In exchange, the city will get approximately 255 acres in Springfield purchased by the railroad company 13 years ago for this purpose.

Work on the shops and yards will start as soon as deeds to the ground are in the railroad company's hands, it is understood. In order that possible litigation

may not hold up the project, the terminal company was organized here today by a group of business leaders. The company will finance the deal if the bonds are held up, and will finance litigation, if necessary, it was announced.

An intensive campaign by a citizens' committee of 100 pro-

ceded the election. The Southern Pacific had previously promised to establish shops and terminals here if the site was provided, as was done today.
