### L'FOLLETT QUILTS SENATE

MARION COUNTY MAN TO RETURN TO PEACH FARM

After two terms in the state legislature as senator from Marion county, Alex M. La Follett, who is approaching 81 years of age, has had sufficient politics, is retiring from active participation and will not be a candidate next year.

Definite statement to this effect was made by Senator La Follett yesterday while in the city. He intends to devote the remainder of his life on his peach ranch north of Salem. Approximately 5,000 boxes of peaches have been harvested this year.

Because of his consistency in voting "no" upon all appropriation measures, Senator La Follett won for himself the appellation of "watchdog of the treasury" while in the legislature.
