

CITY SLEUTH IS ACTIVE

GATHERING OF EVIDENCE UNVEILS SERIOUS CHARGE

What would otherwise have been a charge of drunkenness for Albert Lithen of the Oregon hotel was developed into a charge of drunkenness and driving while intoxicated as the result of the activity Sunday night of Officer Olson of the police department.

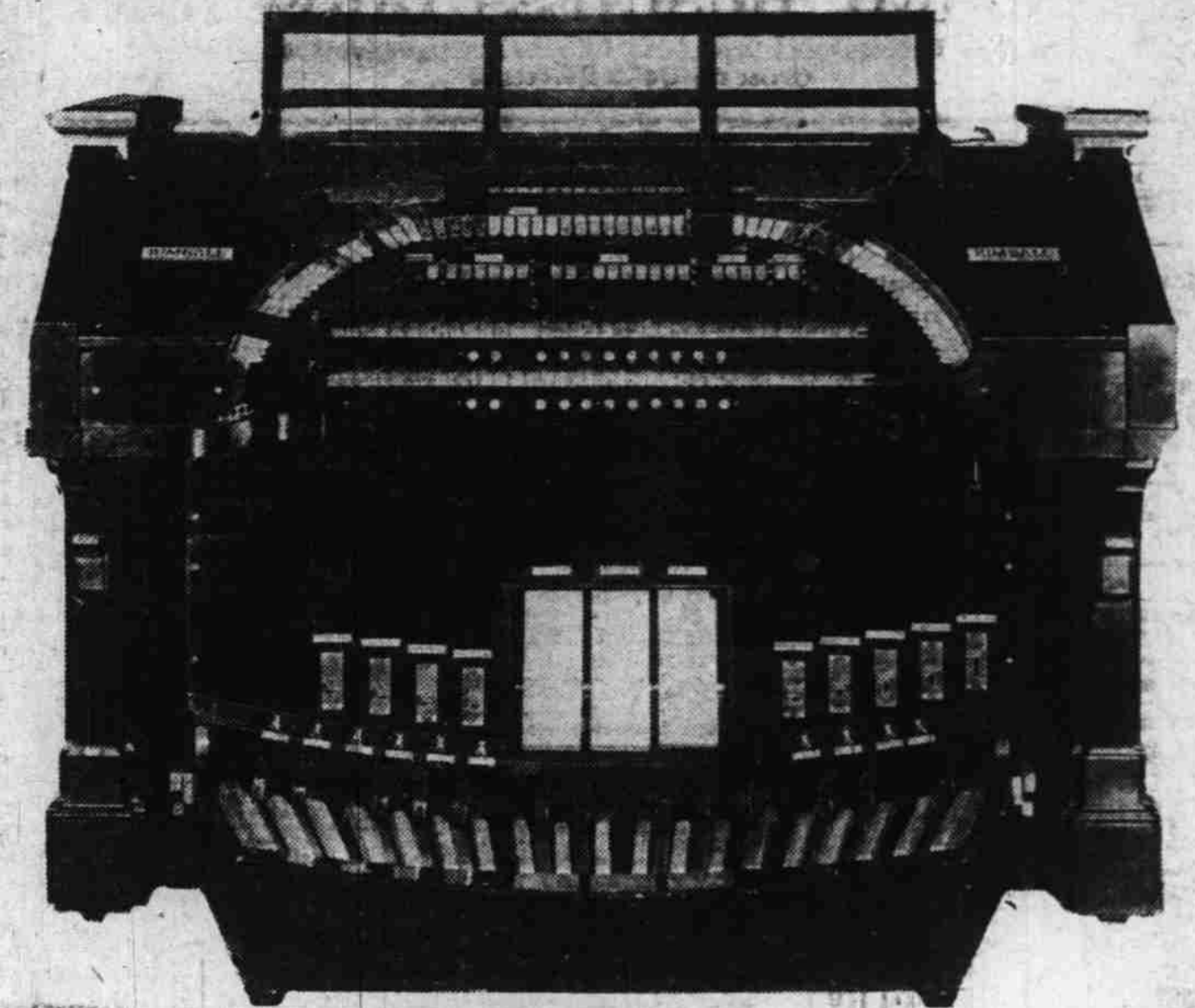
Lithen was arrested by Olson Sunday night in company with Jack Woods of Salem and both were booked at police headquarters on a charge of drunkenness.

Lithen admitted owning a car which he said was stored in a local garage. A short time before a telephone call had come to headquarters that a car, believed to have been driven by a drunken driver, had crashed into a woodpile in the east end of the city. Olson found the stored car and discovered that a headlight had been broken and the front of the car damaged. A trip to the woodpile in question revealed corresponding pieces of the headlight lens and the officer returned to the station where he compounded the charge against Lithen with a complaint charging driving while intoxicated.

Arrested in police court yesterday Woods paid a fine of \$10 for drunkenness and Lithen took 24 hours in which to plead.

HEILIG IS EQUIPPED WITH KIMBALL UNIT; ALL LATEST DEVELOPMENTS ARE EMBRACED

Policy of Theatre is Continued in Salem Playhouse; Work of Installation is Completed by C. M. Balcom, Technical Engineer

Carrying out the completeness of equipment in the new Heilig theater is the Kimball organ, installed by C. M. Balcom, technical engineer for the Kimball company. The organ is declared to be the last word in unification, combining under expression every tone of the pipe organ with unlimited variety of orchestra instruments.

The big organ was designed especially for the Heilig theater, this featuring the policy of the Kimball company to install organs fitted to meet the acoustics peculiar to each house.

Adaptability of the instrument extends from its customary service in interpreting the motion picture to its use as a vaudeville organ. Through deflected shutters the tones of the organ are first conveyed to the stage, then to the auditorium, this feature being of special benefit to the soloist or chorus. The Heilig theater organ gives the performer ample opportunity to synchronize with the organist.

Through the flexibility of the expression chambers each solo stop may be used in accompaniment. From full organ, bringing out the various shadings of an overture, the organist may enter a solo in which the notes of the flute, for instance, stand out.

The various parts of the organ are housed in concrete, sound proof chambers to the right and left of the proscenium arch. To the observer, the control parts of the instrument resemble generally a telephone relay frame. Hundreds of wires, emerging from a cable that connect with the organ in the orchestra pit, branch out to the various pipes and parts of the instrument.

Despite the huge size of the organ, there is a minimum of vibration. The organ is built to give the theatrical operator and the organist the service desired and according to its builder, there is no chance of trouble occurring within the organ itself to hinder the playing of the instrument.

Senator Butler said the special primaries in the west had nothing to do with his decision, declaring that the national committee was taking no interest in the party contests in Wisconsin where Robert M. La Follette, Jr., is seeking the senatorial nomination to succeed his father, or in the other states where they are to be held.

Turning to the forthcoming session of congress, he said he expected tax revision to be taken up promptly, and looked for passage of a satisfactory bill. He knew of no move by manufacturing interests to seek any tariff changes, and his personal opinion was that there would be no concerted move for tariff revision.

Despite the recurring rumors about his appointment to the cabinet, Senator Butler asserted that he expected to be a candidate to succeed himself in the senate next year.

"I will make an announcement

on that subject in due time," he said, but added that, since he did not want to be bashful on the subject, he was willing to say that he would offer for re-election.
