Plans for the largest, best Oregon state fair are outlined in the following program issued tentatively from the office of the State Fair Board. Daily detailed programs, printed by the Statesman, will be at the Fair Grounds on the opening day—tomorrow.

MONDAY—American Legion and Childrens Day, all boys and girls under 12 years admitted free. A fine Legion program is being arranged and prizes in the Legion Drum Corps contest will be awarded as follows: First prize, \$300; second, \$200; third, \$125; fourth, \$75; fifth, \$50. This contest will be judged according to rules adopted at Prineville Legion Convention. There will also be stunts, etc.

TUESDAY—Oregon's and Grange Day—An interesting program has been planned.

WEDNESDAY—Salem, Governor's and Falls Day on which day the Governor's racing derby is scheduled. There is always something doing every minute on this big day.

THURSDAY—Portland, Elks and GAR Day with and martial music and an entertaining general program.

FRIDAY—Hospitality Day. All hospitality clubs of the state will compete in stunts, etc., and the usual daily racing program will be carried out as horse show in the evening.
