



Such a collection is invaluable in the sense that it could never

again be duplicated. The collection, for the most part, includes hags, girdles, and head-dresses. The bead bags are practically all diamond-shape . with the upper apex folded over for the flap. Numerous fresh water shells are used in decking a number of the fringes. One unusually handsome bag of this variety is of a royal blue background with an intensely effective orange and white geometric design interwoven. Another attractive one is bordered with a design of conventionalized foliage; another suggestive of lichens on lush brown moss. Among the belts, one of the most attractive shows the coloring of both honey and sapphires, while another consistently alternates the butterfly and pansy motif, illustrating a favorite myth that a pansy-flower, after all, is only a butterfly imprisoned by the stem on which it strains, while the buterfly typi-
