

BOXING MATCH AT ARMORY LINED UP

32 Rounds of Excellent Ring Work Promised; Five Bouts Are Offered

Five first-rate feature bouts have been arranged for the next boxing match, to be held in the armory here on Wednesday, October 21. Harry Platt, matchmaker, has arranged all details, and every boxer has posted a bond guaranteeing his appearance.

Altogether, 32 rounds of excellent ring entertainment will be offered, considerably more than at any previous match. The main event is guaranteed, in that if the fight patrons are not satisfied, a special ticket will be issued to them for the next boxing match.

Two Salem boys, Shadow Grez and Russel Green, will hold the second place on the program, and will mix things for six three-minute rounds. Both are good and will put on an excellent show.

Sailor Manning of Salem and George Hennings of Vancouver are lined up on the card for four snappy rounds. The fourth bout will be between Jimmy Fargo of Salem and Eddie Fox of Independence. A snappy preliminary will also be offered.

BEARCAT VARSITY BEATEN BY ALUMNI

Former Stars Smash Victory to 20 to 12 Victory Here Saturday Afternoon

Smashing down the field time after time, completing passes when their opponents were not awake, making the best of all the breaks, the Willamette alumni defeated the Willamette varsity 20-12 Saturday afternoon. In Fat Zeller, captain of the graduates, the team of 1925 found an irresistible force. Usually after he had been tackled by two or three men, he was still good for 10 or 20 yards. The varsity members showed an excess of fight and willingness to get under way, but usually it appeared as though they were at a loss as to just where to go.

Rarey put over the first touchdown for the Alumni in the first quarter, after the Alumni had recovered a blocked punt on the Willamette 30-yard line. Zeller had smashed through to within 10 yards of the goal, and Isham had borne the ball to the three-yard line. Isham kicked.

Their second touchdown came in the third quarter when, after two successive first downs and a terrific smash by Zeller to the eighty-yard line, Isham bucked the ball across. The kick failed. Two passes in succession that caught the Bearcats napping both times netted the alumni half the length of the field, and Zeller trotted across for the third touchdown. Zeller attempted to kick, but his effort was blocked, and he raced through the Bearcat line and over the goal for the extra point.

Three successive first downs gave the ball to the Bearcats on the alumni seven-yard line, and an outside penalty against the alumni put the ball within a yard of the goal. Stolzeise put the ball across. Kick failed. In the third quarter, T. Zeller broke away through center for a 35-yard plunge and a touchdown. He bumped up against two or three alumni on the way, but was up like a cat and off again. The kick failed.

The team of 1895, which held a reunion at the occasion, was on the field and received the first kickoff. On the return play McCormick, playing half for the old-timers, got off a 30-yard punt.

by little interest is manifest as to the outcome of the trial. Willos and Kelley, themselves, do not seem to be impressed with the seriousness of the event, although of the two, Kelley is less animated. Willos, apparently, is unmoved by the trial. He, unlike Murray, takes little interest in courtroom procedure, but during intermissions engages in an animated conversation with his co-defendant. Kelley, however, responds shortly to Willos' advances, and for the most part, sits in a dejected attitude.

Willos chews gum continuously and is cool and unabashed. His swarthy face is usually wreathed in a grin. Kelley appears more intelligent of the two, and shows none of the flippancy characteristic of Willos.
