System: Small Tracts at First Advised

Editor Statesman:

It is my belief that one should be content to plant flax in comparatively small acreage, at least during the first years. In mansections of the valley, and with ort 6-n8-inc. many farmers, flax is still an experimental crop.

From my own experience the time of planting seems to be the most important factor, and I am of the opinion that the best results will be obtained when the planting is not later than the first of April. I am of the opinion that each farmer must make rather a close study of his own land and determine for himself the soil most favorable for the crop.
