mates were conditional on such action.

Mr. McCoy estimated that the reduction in total revenue investigated these cuts in the normal rates would be \$40,000,000. Mr. Mellon's suggestion Monday that the surtax rate maximum be reduced to 20 per cent from the present level of 40 per cent was not altered in today's combination.

The secretary's letter was read today at the outset of the fourth day of public hearings by the committee which it plans to continue through next week before beginning work on its new bill. Both republican and democratic members of the committee expressed approval of the new schedule as compared with the suggestions he advanced Monday which called for normal rates of 1 per cent on the first \$2000 of taxable income, 3 per cent on the next \$4000 and 5 per cent on the remainder of the income.

Plans for even greater reductions on these rates, however, have been proposed by both republican and democratic members and pending study of the proposal none would commit himself definitely. Decision on the new rates will not be made by the committee until it concludes its public hearings.

In his letter to Chairman Green, Secretary Mellon explained that the actuary had compiled two schedules for proposed reduction of the normal rates, and that he had finally decided to advance this scheme.
