Juvenile courts declare that the wave of juvenile delinquency now on results in the majority of the cases brought before them, from delinquent parents, broken homes and absence of wise parental authority. And for these conditions father must bear his share of the blame! He should command both respect and obedience as a parent.

Independence to his maturer judgment, his position of responsibility and parental authority with which the father is clothed, the son should be respectful to his counsel which should be directive and not dictatorial.

The father's duty to recognize the old adage that "All work makes Jack a dull boy," to cultivate his boy's companionship, and to know of his other pals, is obvious. He who fails thus in his privileges and responsibilities deserves to reap the harvest of disrespect and regret which generally follows. And the boy who ignores the father's wise counsel through indifference, selfishness or downright disobedience should expect to reap a harvest of disappointment and
