charges because I do not believe any jury could agree on a verdict, and because I believe the people's will has been accomplished without the further expenditure of their money for another trial.

Several of the jurors, however, took issue with the statement that it was a "victory for the prosecution."

"If they had left us alone half an hour longer we would have acquitted," declared one of them, the father of an invalid daughter. "There was nothing to it—we probably would have acquitted on one more ballot," said another while others declared they did not believe the body was hopelessly deadlocked when it was discharged by the court.

Addressing counsel in the presence of the accused man, who was to be free in a few minutes, Judge Johnson said:

"It is an equivalent to acquittal in the eyes of the people, if not in the eyes of the law. In my mind there has been raised a reasonable doubt as to the guilt of the defendant, and I believe this man should be cleared at this time."

ATTORNEY SUING CITY

Carl T. Pope, acting as attorney for himself, wife and other taxpayers whose property abut on Market, D and Belmont streets, has filed suit against the city to prevent the levying of assessment made by the city of Salem for the paving of North Winter street. The plaintiffs claim that the assessment is unfairly large.

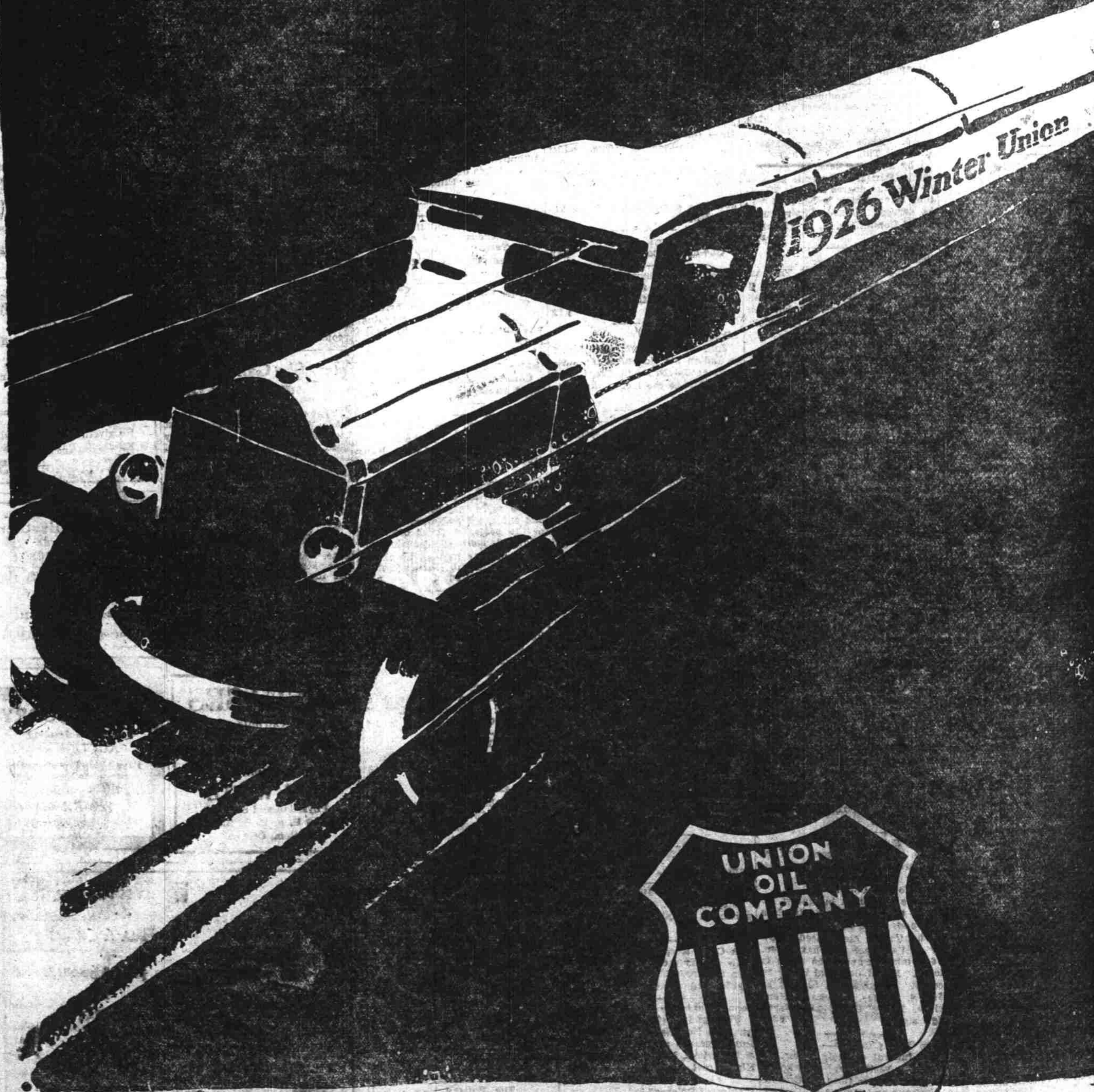
