Mr. Barron said that several months ago he had advised Americans that the United States ought to cooperate in the proposals for stabilizing price of rubber at 18 FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES, mee pence (36 cents) a pound. (Rubber is selling today at slightly more than \$1 a pound.)

He said he had told American users that rubber plantations were going to pieces because of low prices prevailing at that time, that there was no new planting and that increased consumption of rubber by the United States was going right ahead. "I pointed out that no new plantations could he productive in less than six years and that by low prices and prices below the cost of production we were destroying the rubber foundation under our great and growing motor industry," he said. "American manufacturers, however, denounced the 18 pence stabilization proposal and now they are paying the penalty."
