Indians Back to Rice Fields as Harvest Machinery Fails

CASS LAKE, Minn .- Machinery, ally of the pale face, has failed in its efforts to collect rice in the in numerablelakes of Minnesota and the Indians have been temporarily successful in defending their traditional monopoly of the wild rice harvest.

F. J. Scott, acting superintendent of the Consolidated Chippewa Agency here, said this was due to the impracticability of modern machinery rather than to the counter efforts of the red man.

The Indians were greatly alarmed at the appearance of rice harvesting machines. They not only threatened to remove an indespensable means of making a livelihood but literally destroyed the precious fields. The heavy boats necessary to carry the binder-like contraptions ripped the tender stalks from the shallow water, spoiling virtually all rice that the reaper missed.

New tribesmen and their familles in birch-bark canoes and awkward, but light flat-bottom boats, are proceeding as in the days of old.

Radio Listeners Taxed for Their Entertainment

STOCKHOLM.—The radio listener in Sweden must pay for his entertainment but nevertheless license holders increased to 75,000 against 6,000 last year. A fee of 12 krone paid by listeners has provided funds for an improved program. Demand on the present broadcasting stations has necessitated fresh arrangements.

It is planned to build a high power station in the center of the country having a wave length of 1730 meters.

Last night Riley ended a sixyear silence. He told a story of his wife's flight with their children, of the other man, of his long unsuccessful single handed search and asked police and radio to help him find his sons. Shellfire didn't FOR GARDEN PLOWING, BASEMENT daunt him, but his courage had digging and team work, phone 1993. ebbed last night; it was a despairing veteran who told of his vanquished home and family.

Riley is 35 but appeared much older as he sat in his small but neatly kept room at 106 East Locust listening for WHO to broadcast an appeal to his friends for aid.

Left for War Eight Years Ago

"I don't want to trouble my wife," he said, "but I do want to see my boys."

of 1919, I-learned the truth. They

went out west. "I followed them out there, got jobs in Montana, Oregon, Washington and Utah but I could never get trace of them. Then somebody told me they'd gone to Kansas. It was in the fall so I got a job in the harvest fields. But I couldn't find them there.

Searched for Six Years "I've drifted all over the coun try in the last six years and done all kinds of work—all the time trying to find my two kids. "I don't care about her—she

can even keep the kids if I can stay close to them. I've got a bonus insurance policy I want to make out to them and a little money I've saved to give them.

"They're 13 and 11 years old now-it's been eight years since I saw them last. They were 5 and 3 years old then one of them just starting to school."

Riley related his story to police. asking that they request WHO to

aid the hunt. This was done and detectives

are now trying to find Riley's wife through a sister of her secoud husband, who lives in Oregon. "I don't imagine they'll get far with that," Mr. Riley said last night. "I tried to get her to tell

me, but she wouldn't." "Expect I'll hit the trail again in the spring when jobs open up. and see what I can do. I will find them certainly, if I stay at it long enough,"
