The Salem district is the only place in all of our United States that flax is developed on so large a scale for the production of the finer fiber. Fragments of linen have been

found in the graves of the Egyptians showing where Europe and all the world derived its flax. The Egyptians grew and spun the fiber into cloth over six thousand years ago. The specimens found in the King's tombs used as a wrapper for his body are so fine that a magnifying glass is required to distinguish them from silk.

The best work of modern machine looms is coarse in comparison with the fabric of the ancient Egyptian hand loom.

The Miles Linen company constructed a large linen mill this summer. It is the first linen mili in Salem to spin flax and turn out twine. A second linen mill is 000 ni doubling size of plant. soon to be constructed.
