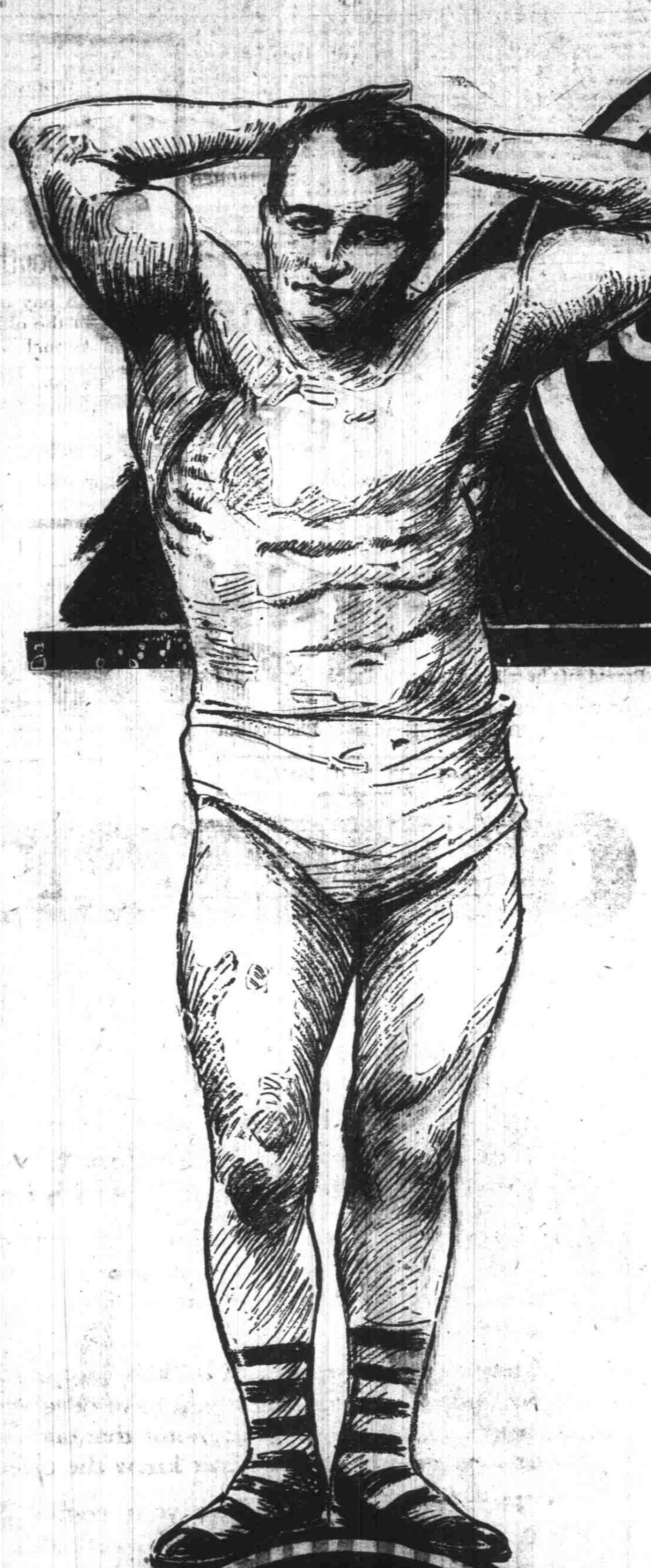
Entire credit for avoiding a panic that might have resulted in the death of numbers of the school students was given Superintendent Powell.
