SALEM IS GRADER CITY OF COUNTRY

When Cannerymen Think of Graders, They Think of Salem, Oregon

Salem is becoming increasingly the city to which cannerymen all over the country turn when they think of fruit graders.

C. J. Pugh & Co., with their factory and office at 550 South Twenty-first street, yesterday shipped a grader to South Haven, Mich., to the South Haven Preserving company. This company bought from the local plant a stock type of grader, which will be used in grading strawberries and other fruits.

There are two orders in from California for graders to be used in grading figs.

Last week, C. J. Pugh & Co. delivered to Libby, McNeill & Libby, at their big plant at the Dalles, a 1926 pear system that is capable of handling 50 tons of pears in 10 hours.

And thus, the orders for graders come in from all over the country, and the work of turning them out piles up.

As usual, the Cherrians will take part in the parade in Salem on Memorial Day, May 31. Carl Gabrielson was named as commander to drill the Cherrians during the absence of Frank Durbin, Jr., who is at present in the east.
