Noted Woman in Brazil Is "Roosevelt of S. A."

DE JANERIO.—(A.P.)-As a result of her experiences in the wilds of Brazil, Emilie Snethlage has become known as the "Roosevelt of South America," and among the country's leading women.

Born in Germany and educated there, she came to this country twenty-one years ago because she believed it least explored by naturalists. She has spent all this time collecting and classifying strange mammals and birds. Unafraid of wild Indian tribes ahabiting a territory far from civilization on the banks of the tributaries of the Amazon and ignoring warnings that no white person could escape death there, she began her explorations alone after becoming head of the zoological department of the Para state museum.

Stories of the deadly fevers, snakes forty feet long, flesh eating fish, poisonous moths and jaguars brought only smiles from her. One of the greatest trips was to a region hitherto uncovered by white people, between the Tapajoz and the Xingu (Shinggew), two large rivers flowing north across the state of Para into the Amazon. She made the trip with Indian guides chosen from native tribes.


