JUDGMENT FAILS TO AID PLAINTIFF

Grant of \$250 Dwindles in Legal Tangle 'Till Nothing Remains

A sample of the vagaries of the law has been given Arthur E. Evans, who recently filed suit for alienation of affections against his wife's parents, charging that they weaned away his wife and daughter, causing them to return to the parental fold.

Evans secured a judgment from Judge McMahan for \$250 out of his original \$15,000 demand, but Carl T. Pope, his attorney, filed a lien on the judgment to get \$100 out of it as attorney's fees.

On top of this his wife filed suit for divorce and Judge McMahan entered an order giving the wife custody of two of their children and temporary custody of the third pending determination of the third pending determination of the divorce, besides dividing up the \$250. Pope gets the \$100 he asked for, Mrs. Evans gets \$150 for suit money, and the county clerk gets the rest for maintenance and support of the children.

ed 17 years before, only after weary months of travel over the frozen Arctic wastes. The thrill following the receipt of this news was shared by everyone everywhere. It was the spontaneous tribute to a brave man for a dar-

ing feat. We, his countrymen, were particularly proud. This man, with a record of distinguished service in the development of aeronautics had, by his brilliant act, added lustre to the brilliant history of the American navy.

"In no way could we have had a more striking illustration of the scientific and mechanical progress since the year 1909. Then Peary's

trip to the pole on dog sleds took about two-thirds of a year. He reached his goal on April 6. It was September 6 before news of the achievement reached the outside world. The naval officer of 1926, using an American invention, the airplane, winged his way from his base at King's Bay, Spitzbergen, and back again in less than two-thirds of a day.

And a few hours later the radio had announced the triumph to the four quarters of the earth. Scientific instruments, perfected by this navigator and one by a representative of this organization were in no small degree responsible for success.

"We cannot but admire the superb courage of the man willing to set forth on such a great ad-

venture in the unexplored realms of the air."

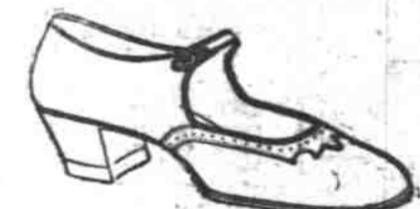

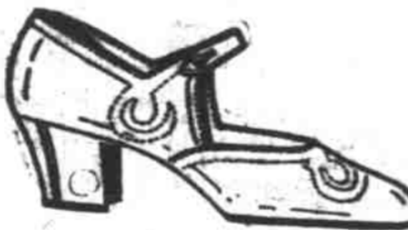
