Such an organized plan could develop 35,000,000 horsepower rom water instead of the present 11,000,000, bring 25,000 miles of modernized waterways on streams and lakes and add 3,000,000 acres of land to the country's agricultural domain by reclamation, Mr. Hoover predicted.

"Our water resources lie all ver the nation," the commerce ecretary explained. "The problems of navigation, power and reclamation simplify themselves as part of a whole program. We do not propose to have all these things done tomorrow; we could not yet use all the resources, but we will need this whole development in a quarter of a century because the population undoubtedly will increase 40,000,000. "At present the shift of eco-

nomic currents resulting from the war have put the midwest in a distorted position. Combined with the Panama canal and water rates which remained the same as before the war, makes the effect of a conspiracy against the great "Unfortunately the whole disadvantages arising are reflect-

ed into the midwestern territory.

With higher labor and material. we can not contemplate much re-

duction in rail rates, as railroads are the most efficient in history. We must seek an alternative. "Experience on the barge sys-

tem between St. Louis and New Orleans shows that transportation can be given at pre-war rail rates with a satisfactory profit. The cost for 1000 bushels of grain to 1000 miles by barge is from \$60 to \$65; while by real it is from \$150 to \$260."
