BEARCATS TO MEET MULTNOMAH MEN

Although the scheduled football game Saturday between Multnomah club and Willamette university was officially called off Wednesday morning by the Multnomah management and the Multnomah team disbanded, the game will be played as scheduled, but in an unofficial manner.

Realizing the plight Coach Spee Keene's men were left in, a group of the ex-Multnomah players, headed by Gene Shields, former University of Oregon star, met Wednesday night and decided to come to Salem and play the game as scheduled.

Ex-Multnomah players who will make the trip to Salem are Gene Shields, captain; Gooding, Norton, Carpenter, Mickelwait, Piper, O'Donnell, Davis, Anderson, Esping, Caplan, Chappell, Plummer, A. Barlow, Blackman, Beckman, Espey and Holmes.

This is a formidable array of players, most of whom are former college stars, and it is hoped to give the Bearcats all the football practice they want to take on. The Bearcats went through a

stiff scrimmage last night and will take a light workout this afternoon in preparation for the game tomorrow. Coach Keene is still pessimistic over the prospects, as his team is not showing much spirit, and a continual stream of players goes to the hospital list every day.

The latest cripple is John Propp, one of the most promising freshman line candidates on the squad, who received a broken ankle in practice Wednesday afternoon and is out for the season. Cramer, a first string end, will be unable to start the game, as will Reidel, who is still suffering from an old injury.

Nakanno, a capable quarterback has two injured legs that slow him up to such an extent that he will not be able to start in the signal calling post, as he otherwise would.

A tentative starting lineup announced by Keene last night, includes Mumford and Ruch, ends; Rhodes and Hartley or Verste, tackles; Mori and McKenzie, guards; Bican, center; Winslow or Jungblom, quarter; Cloninger, right half; Campbell, left half, and Lang, full.

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
