

KEENE OPTIMISTIC OVER NEXT GAMES

Willamette Quintet to Meet OAC and U. of O. This Week in Real Test

No dreams of spectacular victory over OAC and the University are hovering in the subconscious mind of Spec Keene, Willamette university athletic mentor, as he prepares to lead his basketball team to Corvallis tonight and to Eugene for games on Friday and Saturday evening.

Keene was not especially hopeful of making much of a showing against the bigger schools to begin with, but two items of hard luck this week make his team's chances even sadder.

Hartley, veteran center, around whom the team's offensive is built, has been ill for the last three days and has not been able to practice and probably cannot start against OAC tonight. And Riedel, who was another of Willamette's mainstays in the Linfield games, is out with a renewal of the recent injury to his ankle.

Keene announced after Wednesday's practice period that Minto will start at center in Hartley's place; Litchfield and Fleisher will be the forwards and Ledbetter and Ashby the guards. Houk and Zeller are expected to get into the lineup for part of the game.

Against Oregon in the new pavilion on the state university campus at Eugene Friday night, Keene will start the men who make the best showing against OAC. The entire squad will be taken on both of these trips. A second game with Oregon will be played Saturday evening.

Friday will be a big game for the quintet, as a contest has been arranged with Grant high school of Portland. Saturday the hoop squad will meet the Benson polytechnic players.

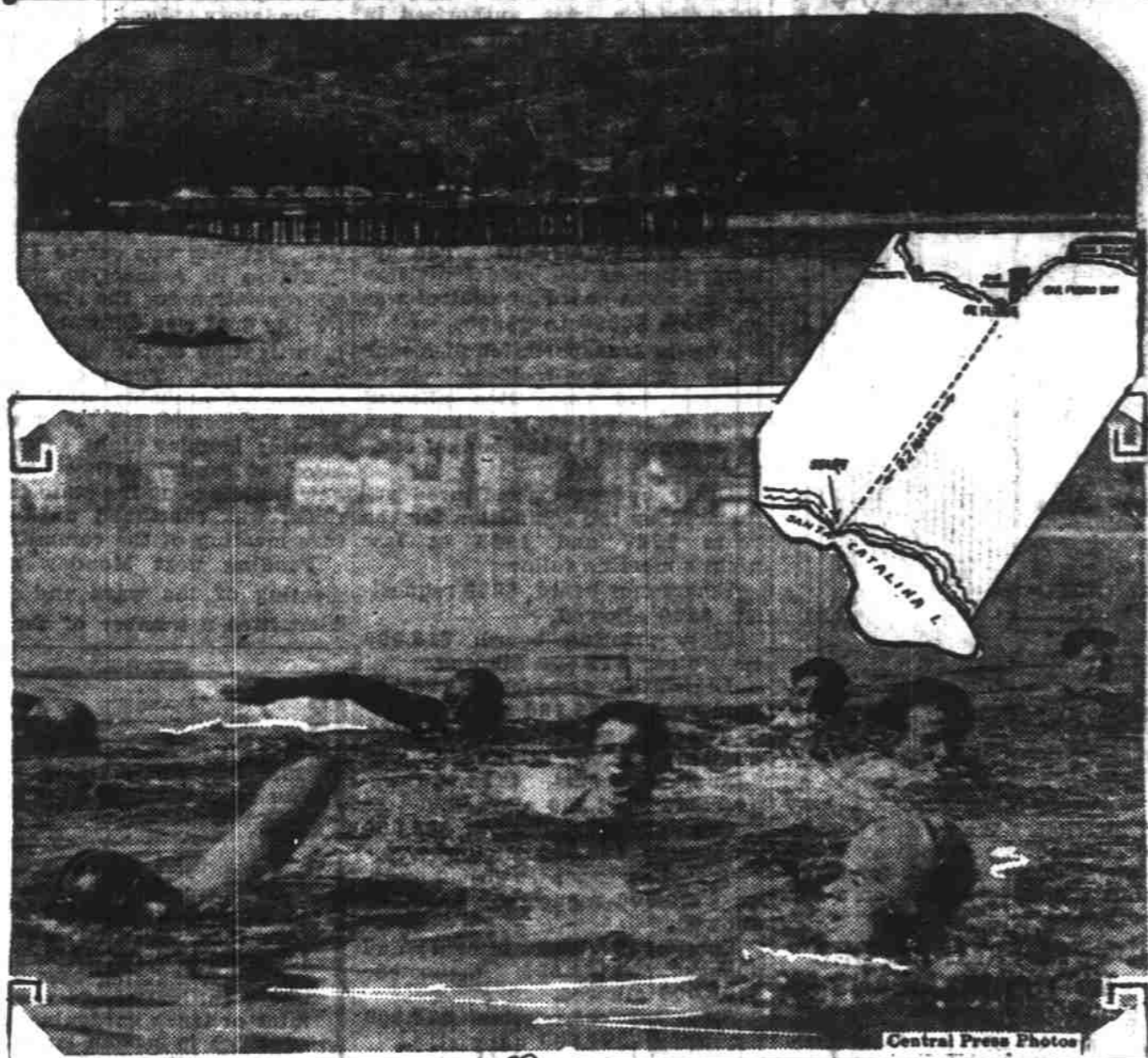

LANDIS DECISION CLEARS PLAYERS

Charge Made by Risberg and Gandil Wiped Off Books By Decision

CHICAGO, Jan. 12.—(AP)—The charge of two baseball outcasts—Charles "Swede" Risberg and Arnold "Chick" Gandil—that the Chicago White Sox of 1917 bought four games from the Detroit Tigers, so that the White Sox would beat out Boston in the tight race for the American league pennant, was wiped off baseball's record book today with scarcely a blemish left to show trace of it.

Kenesaw Mountain Landis, baseball's \$65,000 a year commissioner, in a 3,000 word decision, completely exonerated 21 accused stars of the past and present. There was no punishment of any description—the decision was a complete vindication.

The pool of \$850, admittedly raised by the White Sox of 1917. Commissioner Landis ruled, went to pay the Detroit pitchers as a reward for their achievement in beating Boston, closest rival of the White Sox for the pennant, in an important series, and not as a bribe to the Tigers for "sloughing" a four-game series to the White Sox.

The decision dissected the testimony of the two accusers, Risberg and Gandil, pointing out the weakness of their statement and wound up by saying that Commissioner Landis could not find any truth in what they said. Landis weighed the words of the defending players against the two out-law accusers, and decided to place his faith in the honesty of the accused, thus joining with them in calling the stories of Risberg and Gandil "absolute lies."

In his blanket absolution, the commissioner ruled that Risberg and Gandil had scarcely a reason for basing their framing charges. He cited the fact that no money whatever was mentioned when Gandil said he first arranged the sloughing with "Bill James, the Tiger pitcher under the grand stand before the first game here, September 2, which James denied; that if the money had been promised for that purpose the Detroit players would have been yelling for it long before it was paid; that the money in fact, was not turned over to James until after the Boston series and that no mention of it was made at any meeting of the White Sox until after that series.

Commissioner Landis called further attention to the alleged conversations the two said they had with Clarence Rowland, then manager of the White Sox; Eddie Collins, and others regarding the alleged fixed games and the pool and said it was obvious that these men, and not Gandil and Risberg, were telling the truth. The commissioner likewise did not overlook the mooted question of just how much money was raised to pay off the Tiger pitchers, and where it went. Gandil and Risberg testified they collected about \$1100. Pitcher James said that \$850 was turned over to him, and in his testimony he detailed the distribution of the money, naming the players who got it. The commissioner figured up that 19 players chipped in on the pot, giving up \$45 each, making a total of \$855, which he said made it necessary to take James' word that all he got was \$850.

REPRESENTATIVES HOLD A SHORT MORNING SESSION

HB 6, by Winslow—Pertaining to salaries of elective officers during term of office; referred to committee on elections.

HB 7, by Collier, Graham and Potter—Providing for registration of voters prior to election; referred to committee on constitutional law.
