

sail for China forthwith. General Duncan saw service in the world war at Gallipoli and Eastern Europe, and his new force will consist of about 12,000 menthe Thirteenth and Fourteenth British infantry brigades and the Twentieth Indian infantry brigade with artillery, armored cars and other equipment. Two batallions of the British forces are at Malta, and the remainder are in Great Britain.

Including the 1000 marines

previously ordered to China and the naval ratings of the cruisers dispatched to the Far East the effectives on the spot, it is estimated that about 16,000 men will be available for the defense of British interests. The marines were to have sailed from Ports-mouth today, but their ship was delayed by fog. They probably will get away tomorrow WASHINGTON, Jan. 24.—(AP)

Arrival of American Minister Mac-Murray in Peking yesterday was reported to the state department today by the legation, but he has as yet dispatched no official advices about the situation in China. He left the Chinese capital January 18 for conferences in Washington, only to be halted by cablegram in Korea and directed to return to his post.
