Snow Meter Installed at Seguoia Headquarters

VISALIA, Cal.,--(AP)-A "dry DR. O. L. SCOTT, PSC CHIROPRACTOR -256 N. High. Phone 828-R, or 87. eet" snow meter has been installed at the Alder Creek headquarters of Sesquoia National park, eliminating in the future two day journeys through snowdrifts and boggy meadows to Alta peak, to determine the depth of the snow

thereabouts. The exact depth of the Sierra mountain snow is a reckoning to armers and others interested in next year's water conditions. Heretofore several trips have been made by rangers to obtain this information.

Colonel John R. White, superintendent of the park ordered a giant standard erected on Alta Peak. A six inch telescope was nstalled in the Alder Creek station. 
