NEW YORK, March 24 .-AP) - Householvers was do not Haynes Reappointed go down into the cellar and put t from turning into wine are violators of the eighteenth amendment, according to a decision given in federal court by Judge Augustus N. Hand.

He granted an order confiscatng ten barrels of grape juice which chemists said contained 13 per cent alcohol.

The ruling, attorneys said, af fects the status of farmers who make their own cider and wine. which heretofore has been considered immune to seizure

The wine seized belonged to Mrs. Josephine Malton, who said he'd done nothing but put grape juice in barrels in her cellar.

Her attorney, Eli Rosenberg ergued that it was legal to prepare grape juice for home consumption and that confiscation was irregular unless it were proved that the wine was intoxiating in fact

"The penalties provided in this ct against the manufacture of iquor without a permit shall not apply to a person who manufacfruit juices exclusively for use in what sufferers from head colds and his own home, but such cider an ! fruit juices shall not be sold o




