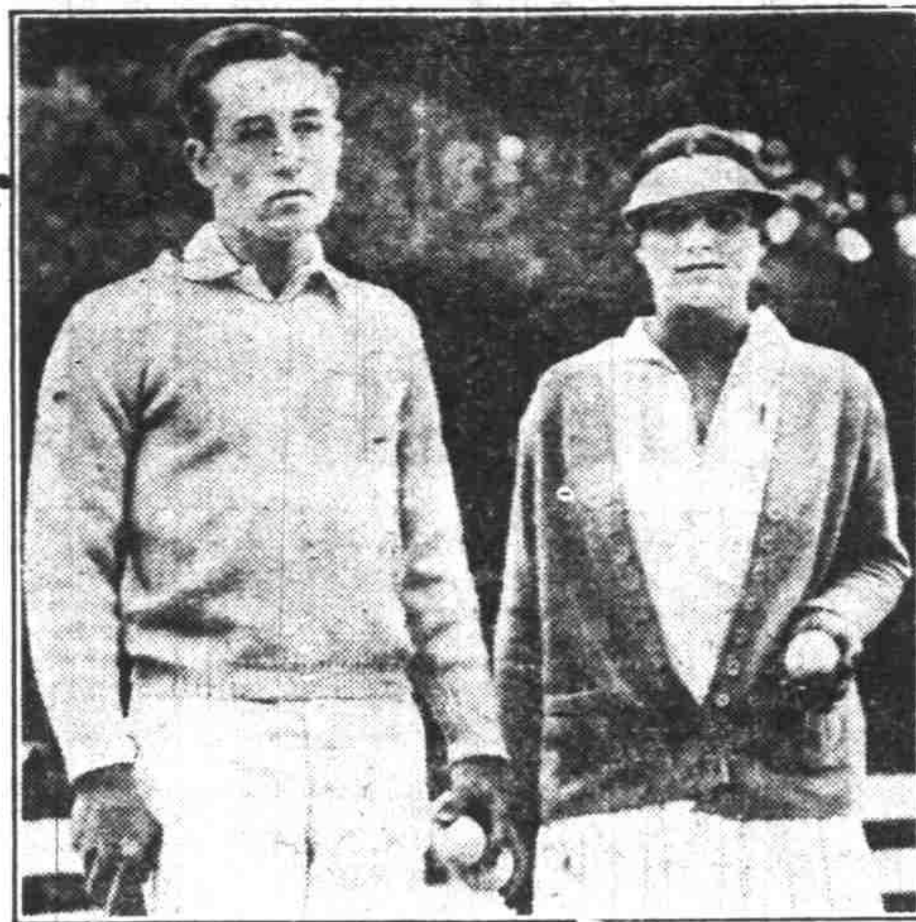

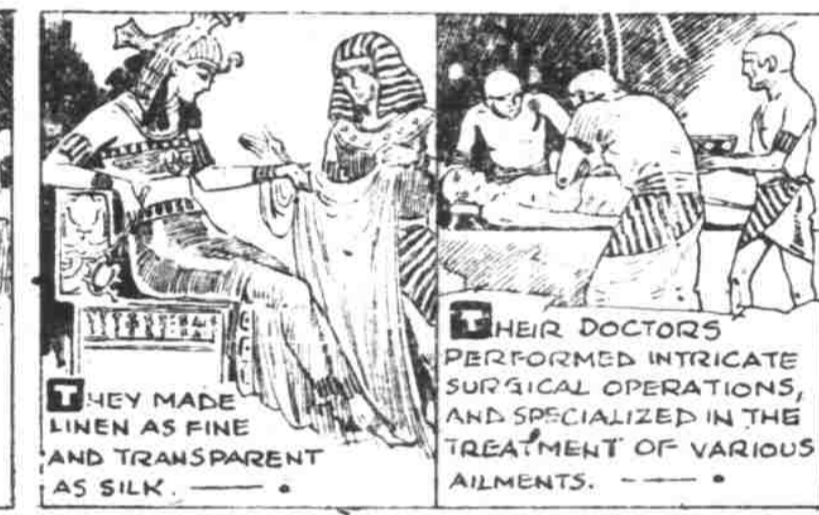
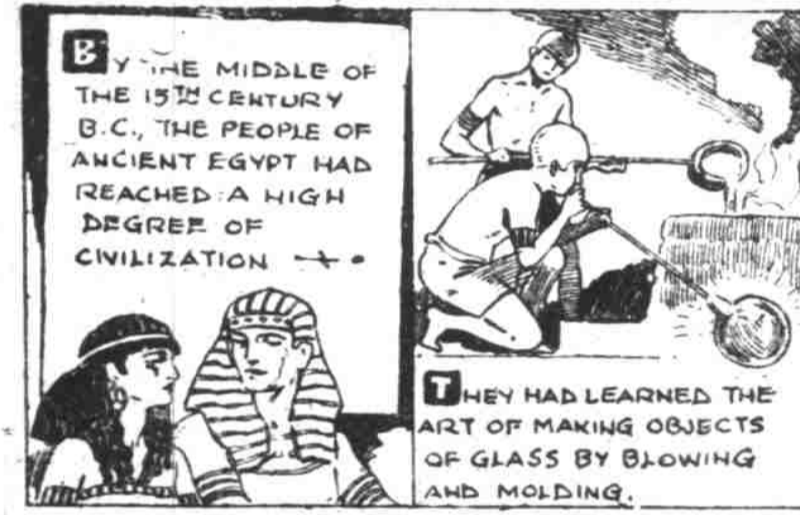

HIGH LIGHTS OF HISTORY

Warrior Kings of Ancient Egypt. By J. CARROLL MANSFIELD

THE CONQUEST AND OCCUPATION OF EGYPT BY THE BARBAROUS HYKSOS (SHEPHERD KINGS) WAS A DARK PERIOD IN EGYPTIAN HISTORY. FOR 200 YEARS, AND PERHAPS MUCH LONGER, THE EGYPTIANS SUFFERED UNDER THE OPPRESSIVE RULE OF THE INVADERS.

ABOUT 1590 B.C., THE EGYPTIANS, INCITED BY THEBAN NOBLES, ROSE IN REVOLT, AND TOOK UP ARMS TO DRIVE THE HATED OVERLORDS FROM THE COUNTRY.

ASSAILED ON ALL SIDES, THE HYKSOS TOOK REFUGE IN THE FORTIFIED CITY OF AVARIS IN THE DELTA. HERE THEY DEFENDED THEMSELVES VALIANTLY, AND WERE DISLORGED ONLY AFTER A LONG SIEGE.

AT LAST THE HYKSOS WERE DRIVEN FROM EGYPT, AND RETREATED SLOWLY INTO SYRIA. THE EGYPTIANS, LED BY THE PHAROAH AHMOSE I (AHMSES), PURSUED THEM A LONG DISTANCE.

WHEN AHMOSE RETURNED TO EGYPT, HE FOUND THE FEUDAL NOBLES OF THE SOUTH IN REVOLT. AFTER THE UPRISING WAS QUELLED, THE LANDED NOBILITY WAS ABOLISHED, AND THE ESTATES WERE SEIZED BY THE CROWN.

AHMOSE THEN TOOK UP THE TASK OF BUILDING UP THE KINGDOM. EGYPT NOW HAD A LARGE AND EFFICIENT ARMY, AND THE WHOLE LAND WAS ROUSED WITH THE DESIRE FOR CONQUEST.

AMENHOTEP I AND THUTMOSE I, WHO FOLLOWED AHMOSE, WERE WARRIOR KINGS LIKE THEIR PREDECESSOR. THUTMOSE CONQUERED NUBIA TO THE 4TH CATARACT, AND PENETRATED INTO SYRIA AS FAR AS THE EUFRATES RIVER.

AT THE DEATH OF THUTMOSE I, THE WORK OF RESTORING EGYPT TO HER FORMER GLORY WAS CARRIED ON BY HIS DAUGHTER HATSHEPSUT. THIS FAMOUS QUEEN REBUILT THE TEMPLES THAT HAD BEEN DESTROYED BY THE HYKSOS.

HATSHEPSUT AND HER HUSBAND, THUTMOSE III, HAD SEIZED THE THRONE. FROM THUTMOSE II, AND RULED AS JOINT SOVEREIGNS. THUTMOSE III WAS JEALOUS OF HATSHEPSUT'S POWER AND WAS CONSTANTLY PLOTTING AGAINST HER.

AFTER HATSHEPSUT DIED (1479 B.C.), THUTMOSE III REIGNED FOR 33 YEARS ALONE. HE WAS THE GREAT CONQUEROR OF EGYPTIAN HISTORY, FIGHTING 15 CAMPAIGNS IN SYRIA, AND CONSOLIDATING AN EMPIRE THAT EXTENDED FROM THE 4TH CATARACT ON THE Nile TO THE EUFRATES.

ONE ACCOUNT OF THESE CAMPAIGNS RELATES HOW THE EGYPTIANS CAPTURED THE CITY OF JOPPA BY SMUGGLING PICKED SOLDIERS THROUGH THE GATES IN PALMNIERS, BORNE BY DONKEYS.

AS A RESULT OF THESE CONQUESTS, ALL LANDS WERE FORCED TO PAY TRIBUTE TO THE PHAROAH, AND EGYPT BECAME THE TREASURE-HOUSE OF THE WORLD.
