Canned fruits and berries can be shipped from Salem, via the Panama canal to cities on the Atlantic coast for 54 cents per hundred Bounds, same as Indianapolis, Ind. With such conditions, it is inevitable that real estate in Salem and its trading territory is bound to increase in value. In no city of the northwest do such favorable conditions exist,
