(b The driver of any vehicle upon a highway within a business or residence district shall yield the right of way to a

prolongation of the lateral boundary lines of the adjacent

or traffic direction devices. Every pedestrian crossing a highway within a business or residence district at any point other than a pedestrian crossing, crosswalk or intersection,
shall yield the right of way to vehicles upon the highway. (c) The driver of a vehicle entering a public highway
from a private road or drive shall yield the right of way to all vehicles approaching on such public highway, and shall
come to a full stop before entering such public highway. 8. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the driver of a vehceple intending ot turn to the right at an inter-
section shall approach such intersection in the lane for traffic nearest to the right-hand side of the highway, and in turning edge of the highway and when windelending to to turn to the left edge or the highway and when intending to turn to the left
shall approach such intersection in the lane for traffic to the
right of and nearest to right of and nearest to the center line of the highway and in
turning shall pass beyond the center of the intersection, passing as closely as practicable to the right thereof before turnsuch vehicle to the left
For the purpose of this section, the center of the inter-
section shall mean the meeting point of the medial lines of section shall mean the meeting point of
the highways intersecting one another.
(b) Local authorities, in their respective jurisdictions,
may modify the foregoing method of turning at intersections where either intersecting roadway is less than eighty feet in width and in intersections where streets meet at other than
right angles and in intersections where one street terminates in another, by clearly indicating by buttons, markers or other direction signs within the intersection, the course to be fol-
lowed by vehicles turning thereat, which buttons, markers or owed by vehicles turning thereat, which buttons, markers or
other signs shall be placed at every intersection of the medial ine of each street with the prolongation of the property lines of the intersecting street, if possible, otherwise as near the intersecting point of said lines as may be practical. It shall

turn by extending the hand and arm horizontally from and
