Inherited Hospitality

But I know many people who could live their lives in the expansive setting of Sunnybank without acquiring the Terhune expansiveness. The quainty of genuine hospitality, I believe, is inherited. But I believe, too, that it is one of the easiest of inherited qualities to kill. Many Americans in the cities have inherited a tradition of hospitality from ad-OLDSMOBILE mirable ancestors, but have found it economical and convenient to
