COSGRAVE REPAYS DEBT

WASHINGTON, Jan. 26.—(AP)—President William T. Cosgrave of the Irish Free State executive council Wednesday repaid a debt of 150 years standing. Addressing the senate after he had shaken hands with each of its members in an impromptu reception, the Free State executive said: "Benjamin Franklin came to my country a hundred and fifty years ago and told the Irish parliament that the Irish people and the Americans alike were fighting for freedom. I have now come to repay the visit of that great man."

It came after he had first paid homage to the father of the country during a visit to the home of George Washington at Mount Vernon and had visited informally with representatives during a recess of the house.
