My dear Mr. Hillman:

In reply to your letter of October 11 relative to your installation of a #24 "Iron Fireman" in one of the boilers of the Oregon Normal School and also the recent addition of the #6 "Iron Fireman" in the second boiler here, may I say that our highest anticipations have been realized to the fullest.

In the first place, we cut down our heating plant force from two men to one and he declares his work much lighter than when he fired with wood with another man assisting him. As to the expense, we are using now from two and a half to three tons of Black Diamond coal; whereas we were using formerly seven to eight cords of wood. Added to all this is the fact that our buildings were never so satisfactorily heated as they were this past winter. We never had any difficulty as we had had so often with wood in having sufficient heat.

Fact is that the experience with the Iron Fireman has been so satisfactory that we are planning to not only remain on that basis here in the Normal School at Monmouth, but to install the Iron Fireman in the two furnaces of the new training school at Independence. Up to date, our experience has been such that we very heartily recommend the Iron Fireman because of the efficient service it gives and the ease with which it is handled and the dependability of its operation.

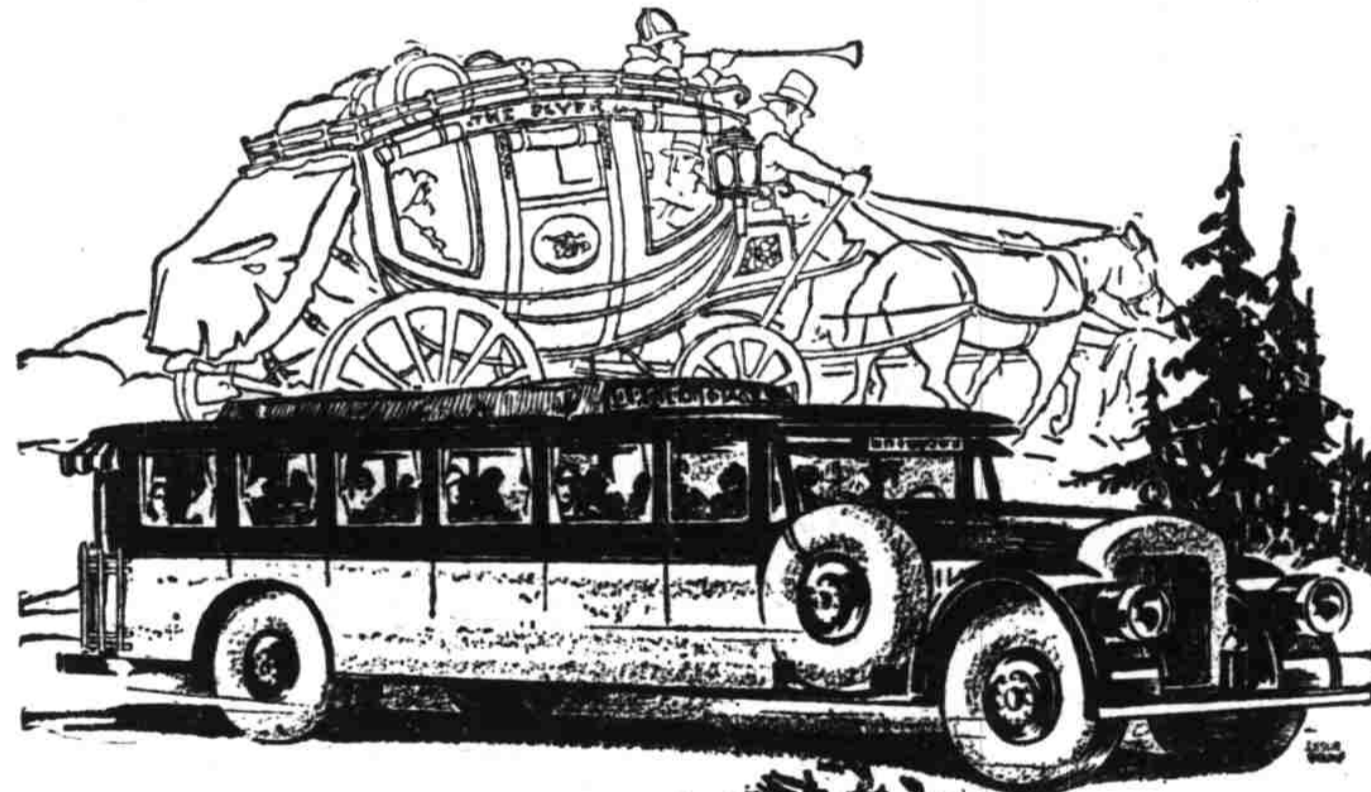
