

## More Vegetables Coming While Prices on Decline

Market conditions in the vegetable and fruit lines as given by the Salem wholesale establishments are found in brief to present the following:

California asparagus is now coming into the market in plentiful quantities, with a sharp decline in prices noticeable. Yesterday prices ranged from 15 to 20 cents per pound, wholesale.

Florida strawberries, which reached the Portland markets over a week ago, have been temporarily taken from the market, due to poor quality of berries that will not stand the trip north.

Those who must have early strawberries will not be disappointed long, however, for within a few days a fancy and good keeping grade of berries will be shipped from Tampa.

Oranges now available are of very high sugar test and are in the best season of the year. They are moving rapidly, with California quoting prices the same as last week.

Lemons are coming onto the market in a trifle greater quantity than the consumer is requiring. This excess of supply over demand has caused a small decline in the lemon market, with present quotations being from \$6 to \$6.75 per crate.

Florida grapefruit is showing strength, with brokers holding for a 25 to 50 cent raise per case over last week. The wholesale bulletin notes that with the present price the best grades cannot be secured as the poorer qualities, which otherwise couldn't be sold,

have worked in and are now being shipped.

The yam or Porto Rican sweet is coming through in good delivery, with prices declining. They are now \$2.25 to \$2.50 a crate.

Brussels sprouts have undergone little change since last week, the quality continuing excellent.

Artichokes are higher by a trifle, but the market is producing a better grade, with prices quoted at from \$1.10 to \$1.50 a dozen, according to size.

Eggplant, for which there has been no demand in Salem, is still too high for the general trade, with 25 cents per pound on the fancy stock prevailing.

The shipment of large quantities of outdoor rhubarb from California has resulted in a slight decline, with price at 9 cents per pound.

The potato situation continues to look up, with more strength in evidence daily for all grades. Quotation is \$1.50 to \$2.25 per cwt. There has been no activity in the seed potato market.

Hot house cucumbers are quoted at less than last week, with from \$1.75 to \$2.25 prevailing for each dozen.

Mexican tomatoes, fine quality, are still the only tomato on the market. They go to the retailer at about 25 cents a pound.

Florida green peppers are coming through in greater quantity, which is leaving mark on prices by a decline to 20 cents per pound.

Local cabbage has entirely disappeared, with California and

Spokane supplying the market; both are shipping good quality at prices ranging from \$2.50 to \$4 per cwt.

In the last few days a decline has been noticeable in the cauliflower market, with the best grade commanding from \$1.25 to \$1.40 per crate.

Parsley of fine quality is 80 cents per dozen to the retailer.

California outdoor long red radishes are quoted at 80 cents a dozen.

Local turnips are 2 cents a pound, with only a limited amount of the bunch crop available at 80 cents a dozen.

Bunch beets and carrots from California are of good grade, the former at \$1.15 per dozen and carrots 80 cents per dozen for the new ones. Local carrots are still obtainable at 3 cents a pound.

The California lettuce market is showing a firm tone with prices on all grades advancing daily, the outlook being for \$5 lettuce in the near future. For a while the
