Healthy gums can bear massaging just as the flesh around the fingernails can, with beneficial results. In fact, the exposed surfaces of unhealthy inflamed gums when given a correct massage with a stiff bristle brush twice a day will show wonderful improvement in the course of a week or ten days.

The brushing of the teeth and gums in a correct manner is of great importance. The slight pain that comes on during the first week's brushing may be compared to the muscle beins of an athlete when he firsts starts to get himself into condition. The trainer tells the athlete to go on with his work and that the stiffness will wear away, and it usually does. In the same manner, the patient who fears he is injuring his gums when he uses the tooth brush correctly must realize that he must continue, and by continuing this, the discomfort will disappear.

The gums keep in fit condition when they are brushed often. This is so because bacterial masses and also the dead epithelial cells which furnish part of the bacterial food are removed. When proper brushing first takes place, when done too strenuously, unbrushed spots are uncovered and there is apt to be at first a slight systemic reaction which shows itself in soreness of

Efficient cleansing can give remarkable results, particularly then it is done correctly and often. Ordinary mouth antiseptics and dentifrices bave a great value at times, but for ordinary service their value is not very great when compared to efficient brushing.

If the brush bristles are too stiff the brush should be placed in hot water for a minute before using until the gums have become accustomed to genuine cleansing. 


