SPOKANE, Sept. 26 .- (AP)-Archie Much was formally charged here with having decoyed Mrs. Katherine Clark of Boston, Mass., to Spokane under promise of marriage, and with slaying her with a hatchet to get her money.

The murder charges were filed after Sheriff Floyd Brower of Spokane county dug up in the back yard of Much a roll of bills believed to have been brought here by the woman, and a bundle of love letters which police say Much wrote to her.

The letters were of the type usually exchanged through "matrimonial bureaus" and implored the Boston divorcee, in endearing terms, to come to Spokane and to bring her money along too. They were signed "Jim Murphy," expressed the longing of "Murphy" to marry Mrs. Clark, and told of his "great wealth."

Prosecutor C. W. Greenough said he believed that Much, who is married and has five children. wrote to the woman as "Jim Murphy," persuaded her to come to Spokane and stay at his house, then took her out in an automobile last Saturday night under pretext of meeting "Murphy" whom he said lived across the Idaho


