## FLYER DROPS OUT OF HIS AIRPLANE

WINDSOR, Ont., Oct. 25 .-(AP)-Arthur D. Strevett, 19, of Windsor, a student flier, plunged 4000 feet to his death and R. H. Soundy, 34, his instructor, escaped a similar fate by clinging to a strut on their biplane when they were thrown from their seats while flying over Essex county near Maidstone, Ont.

The accident occurred when the flyers lost control of the plane and it turned over. Neither was strapped in his seat.

Unmanned, the plane ran wild in the air for a few moments but Soundy managed to climb back into the cockpit, right the craft after it had fallen to within 800 feet of the ground and bring it to

earth safely. Srevett was thrown clear of the plane. His body which struck a tree as it fell was found an hour and a half after the accident by Charles D. Strevett, his father, and a brother Norman.
