"There is not one text in all the Bible that commands anybody to keep Sunday as a sacred day. Neither is there one text in the Bible that says that Christ or His disciples ever kept that day," declared Professor Charles T. Everson Sunday night at the

"In fact the first day of the week (Sunday) is only mentioned nine times in the whole Bible. So if anywhere Sunday is spoken of as being a sacred day it would be found in one of these nine places. The first text is found in Genesis I and speaks of Sunday as being the first day of creation. The first day of the week is not again mentioned in the old Testament but appears the second time in Matthew 28:1. In this text Matthew wrote many years after Christ had gone to heaven that the first day of the week came just after the Sabbath. So Sabbath and Sunday

were two distinct days. "The third text is found in Mark 16:1, 2 and again states that the women waited until the Sabbath had passed and upon Sunday came to the tomb to annoint Christ. Mark wrote this text during the Christian dispensation 25 years after Christ had gone to heaven. The fourth text is found in the same chapter and the ninth verse and says that Jesus appeared to Mary the same day that He was resurrected.


