Muscular Rheumatism
Will you please explain what muscular rheumatism is? Does one feel stiff from it? And is it true that some people are of the type that must have rheumatism without being able to cure it? Can it be distinguished from neuralgia? "MRS. J."

Muscular rheumatism is a much abused term to describe painful symptoms in the muscles. There may be real inflammation of the muscles—myositis—with swelling and tenderness. The muscles may be affected by an acute inflammation of the joints, as in acute rheumatic fever, and the nerves of a muscle may be inflamed—neuritis—giving the impression that the muscles are affected. There is also painful spasm of the nerves without inflammation, which is called neuralgia, that sometimes goes under the name of muscular rheumatism.

No, it is not true that some people are of the type that must have rheumatism. A competent, physician and have a diagnosis made and correct treatment given. Mrs. J. You may have some focus of infection that is setting in your joints or you may be on an unbalanced diet, or there may be some other cause for your so-called rheumatism.

Must I Count Calories?
"Is the knowledge of the calorie values of foods necessary when one knows approximately the carbohydrate, fat and protein contents of the foods and has advantages of good scales and uses daily? Is it possible that there can be overeating of such foods as lettuce and all other vegetables (excepting potatoes) and skim milk?"

No, counting the calories is only necessary when the weight is not normal, and in some other disorders. Yes, it is possible, but not probable, that one will overeat of such foods as lettuce and other vegetables. An excessive consumption might be harmful if it would mean the limitation of other needed foods. It must be constantly remembered that a balanced diet is necessary. Vitamins are not more important than mineral elements, or protein, or sufficient energy food. Too much of the energy foods—the starches, sugars and fats—will result in overweight and also an imbalance of the other elements which may also produce a deficiency disease. Too little of the energy foods would result in underweight unless one had sufficient body fat to supply the energy needs.
