

SALEM EXCHANGE HAS 6580 PHONES

The Salem telephone exchange had a total of 6580 telephones served from the local office on November 30, according to a report released Tuesday. This represented a gain of 373 telephones over the same period a year ago when 6138 telephones were used here.

In the local exchange are 1090 farm telephones users, which leaves a net of 5490 users in the city proper. One year ago 1073 farm users were reported, the largest part of the gain in 1928 being made in the city itself.

Today's Recipes
Corn Cakes—One cup yellow cornmeal, one and one-half cups cake flour, two eggs, two tablespoons sugar, three tablespoons melted butter, one teaspoon salt, six teaspoons baking powder, one cup milk. Beat together egg, sugar, salt and milk; add cornmeal and flour sifted with baking powder, then add the butter and mix

until a smooth batter is obtained. Bake same as wheat cakes.

Glorified Gingerbread—Mix as for pie crust the following ingredients: One cup sugar, two cups flour, one-half cup shortening, one-half teaspoon cinnamon, one-half teaspoon ginger. Take out one-half cup of above mixture and to the balance add one egg, two tablespoons baking molasses, one cup sour milk, one teaspoon soda, one-half teaspoon salt. Pour this batter into well-greased pan and sprinkle remaining mixture over top. Bake in moderately hot oven about 25 minutes.

Tapoca Pudding—Put a quart of milk and a half glass of evaporated milk, diluted, with a half glass of water in a saucepan. When warm, add four full tablespoons of minute tapioca. When it comes to a boil, allow it to simmer eight minutes. Beat the yolks of four eggs very light, adding a tablespoon of sugar and two tablespoons of water. Stir into the cooked tapioca and remove from stove. Heat the four whites of the eggs beaten very stiff. Take one tablespoon of the beaten whites and fold it into the tapioca, then add the butter and mix
