# STOCK PRICES

Easier Call Money Was Reason for Rallies in Many Quotations

NEW YORK, Jan. 17 .- (AP) -The stock market showed the most pronounced strength of the week today, as a moderate ease in the call money market prompted short covering and restored bullish confidence.

There had been but little thought on an increase in the New York federal reserve rediscount rate this week, and what uncertainty was still felt on this point was largely dissipated in the morning by the Bank of England report, showing no change in its rate and a sharp improvement in its reserve ratio. The position was so improved that Wall street no longe rexpects a higher rate in New York to be preceded by an increase at London.

Metal shares generally moved forward. U. S. Steel touched 173%, the highest price since the 40 per cent stock divident two years ago. St. Joseph lead was again heavily bought, mounting nearly 11 points to a new high, reflecting its excellent earnings last year. Chile was the favorite of the generally stronger coppers, mounting about eight points, as reports that Anaconda would make an exchange offer to minority stockholders were revived. Rails generally improved, New

York Central moving up five points to 194 as favorable action on its petition to lease its large controlled lines was freely forecast. Motors made fair progress. Packard gaining more than five points, and merchandising shares generally rallied, Sears Roebuck point advance on formation of the new Insuli Holding company.

Radio was a high flier, surging up nearly 18 points, but losing the fourth day of his illness. about five points of its gain later. Electric Auto Lite shot up more than 11 points to a new top, and By-Products Coke climbed nine.
