# KIDNAPED PRIEST IS

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 1. - (A P) -A cablegram received here tonight stated that the Rev. Edward Young, an American mission. ary, kidnapped and held for ransome by Chinese bandits near Nananfu, Kiangsi province, had been released and was well and safe.

The cablegram, signed by Bishop O'Shea, of the Catholic mission at Kanchow to which Father Young was attached, was received by the very Rev. S. Maune, provincial of the priests of the congregation of the mission. It was dated Kanchow, Kiangsi, China, and read: "Father Young released; well

and safe." Father Maune was unable to supply any further details. He did not know whether the young missionary had been released voluntarily or whether any part of the bandits ransom demand has been

Reports of the kidnapping of Father Young, who is 30 years old and one of the youngest missionaries in the field in China, were received from Bishon O'Shea on January 26. The bishop stated that the kidnappers were communists and had demanded ransom of \$10.
