
# PRICE FIXING LAID

LOS ANGELES, Feb. 8-(AP) Charges that a number of large oil compants have conspired to, and are "fixing" the price on gasoline in southern California, are to be instigated by John H. Amen. special asssitant to the federal attorney general, he said here today. Complaints were made by mem bers of the Independent Super Service Station association to Amen alleging that the Shell, Union, Standard, Texaco, Richfield and General Oil companies are violating the Sherman anti-trust act.

The Independent association members allege specifically that the major companies have fixed the wholesale prices at 14 1/2 cents a gallon, and that they are leas-Drs. O'Nelli & Burdette, uptometrists Phone 625 401-402-403-404-405 ing their own stations on a salary basis to individuals who are thus able, and are instructed to sell gasoline at a price far below what the independent dealers can sell. It is further charged that these major companies maintain several retail stations where the price is kept at 20 1/2 cents a gallon in order that the wholesale price to independents may be based on the retail figure. Many independent dealers are

being forced into bankruptcy. H. R. West, president of the association, declared. Amen said that if the association can prove the charges that he will place the case in the hands of the United States district attorney here.
