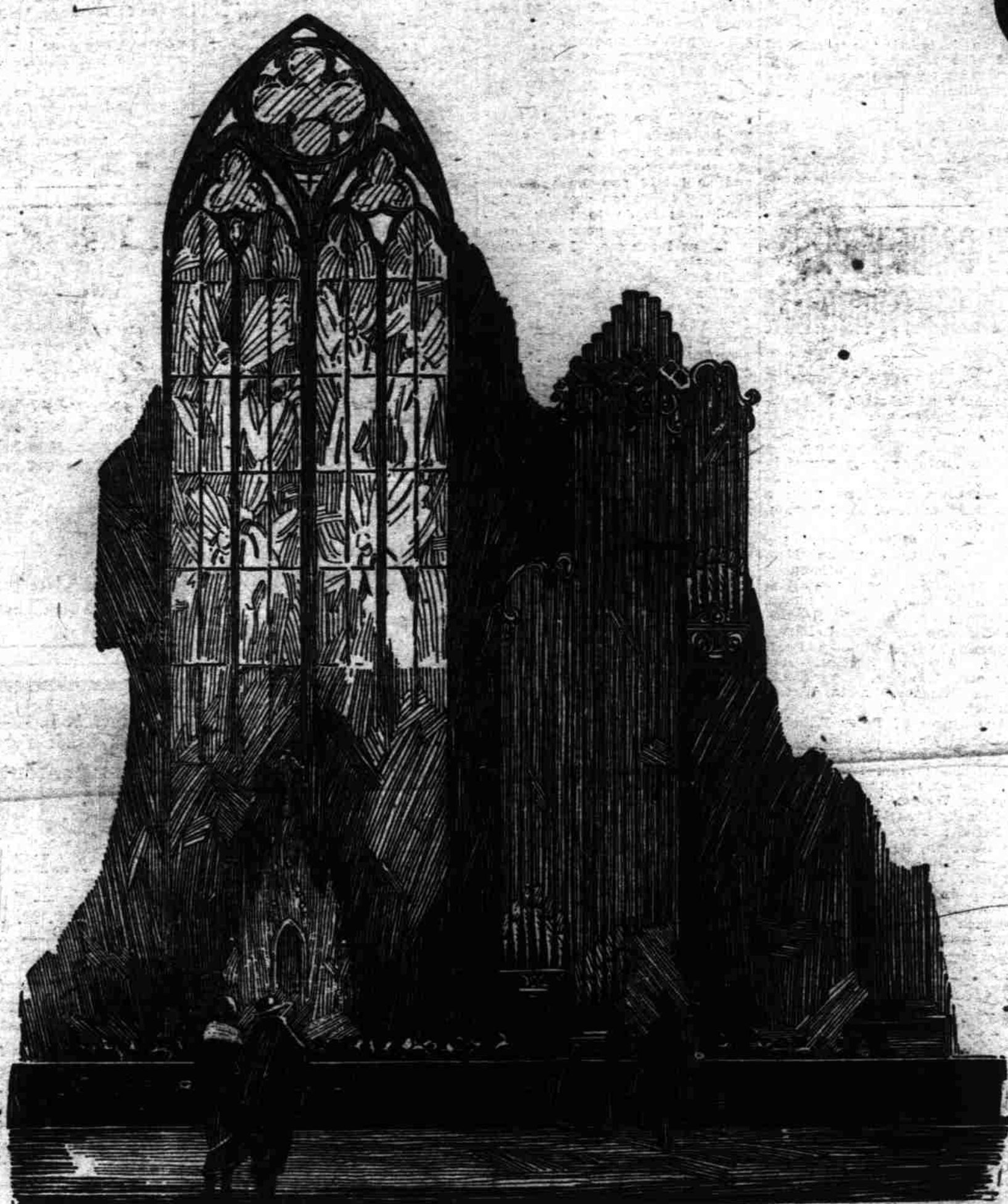


# Go to Church on Easter
