

Valsetz Reservoir to Store 2,000,000 Gallons of Water

FLUME ADDS TO STORAGE TANKS

Protection From Fire Made by Burying Flume Underneath Ground

VALSETZ, June 10.—There should not be the water shortage here this summer as previously experienced. The reservoir has been enlarged to a capacity of 2,000,000 gallons. A new flume has been constructed which will divert another large creek into the reservoir. The flume is built of good cedar planking, 45,000 feet of lumber being used. It is just short of 1 mile in length and is buried under ground which is a great protection in case of forest fire. Unless there is an unreasonable waste there should be at least 1-2 more water in reserve than usual during the warm weather.
